

iFeed Q&A



WHAT is iFeed?

iFeed 11.7.15 is a one-day event where High School Interact members will work toward alleviating hunger in the world and in our own communities.

HOW will iFeed do this?

In **TWO PARTS: PART 1** of the event is to pack 52,000 highly nutritious, vitamin-fortified soy-rice meals that will be shipped to Nicaragua (with the help of the organization called Kids Against Hunger). This will involve over 24 teams (240 volunteers) packing for about 4 hours total. **PART 2** is to collect food for one of the largest food drives that our communities have ever had. **Interact is asking the community to join in and be a part of iFeed in Part 2.**

WHO is putting on iFeed?

The five La Crosse Area Interact Clubs - including Aquinas, Central, Holmen, Logan and West Salem High Schools. What is Interact? It's Rotary for high schoolers. Its mission is the same as Rotary - SERVICE ABOVE SELF.

WHEN and WHERE is iFeed?

iFeed 11.7.15 is on Saturday, November 7, 2015 and will be held at Logan High School from 9am to 3pm.

Why should people get involved in iFeed?

Because the need is so great. Hunger is a real issue—in foreign countries as well as in our own back yards. The 52,000 meals will be shipped to Nicaragua where children would go without food if it weren't for the food packages sent by organizations such as Kids Against Hunger. These meals are prepared in schools and churches that function as schools, so the children are fed, and also receive a basic education. Locally, the need for food is a constant challenge. All food collected during iFeed will be donated to the Hunger Task Force—which in turn supplies any and every food pantry in the La Crosse area and beyond. So iFeed truly will benefit every area food pantry.

HOW CAN YOU help iFeed?

Get your school, place of worship, place of business, service organization, neighborhood or any other club, group or team together and plan a food drive. Your rules, your goals, your incentives = your outcome! Set your own time frame - 2 weeks before, 1 week before, however you would like to run your food drive.

THEN ON 11.7.15... bring your collection to Logan High School from 9am-3pm and be a part of the largest food drive EVER! Feel good about what your group has done, how you have helped and how you can keep helping!
